## **Editorial Note**

This is the third Special Issue of the *Nordic Wittgenstein Review*. It is edited by Sandra Laugier, Mickaëlle Provost, and Jasmin Trächtler, and dedicated to the theme "Wittgenstein and Feminism".

Our first Special Issue, "Wittgenstein and Forms of Life", edited by Danièle Moyal-Sharrock and Piergiorgio Donatelli, appeared in November 2015, and the second one, "Post-Truth", edited by Rupert Read and Timur Uçan, in July 2019.

NWR welcomes proposals for further guest edited special issues, which present an opportunity to explore a topic from diverse perspectives in one issue of the journal. There is no fixed deadline for submission of proposals, but Special Issues occur at most once every 1–2 years. Scholars interested in guest editing an issue are welcome to contact the editor-in-chief for details. Decisions about publication are made by the editorial board.

The current Special Issue is first published for a four week open review period. This means that we invite comments and discussions on these articles. Our hope is to engage the community in a process of collaborative review, with the aim of enhancing the scholarly value of the contributions. After the four-week open review period, the authors have an opportunity to revise the preprint version of their submission.

To comment on an article, please send a mail to the guest editors. Commentators are expected to appear as peers i.e. by their real names.

## OPEN REVIEW GUIDELINES

- 1. In your comment, please refer by article name and page number, or by quoting the passage you comment.
- 2. We seek constructive commentary and criticism that may help the author improve the text. The discussion is moderated by the editors.

3. Please note that Prepublication versions of articles are works in progress. Remember that the final version will be published after the four-week open review period. If you nevertheless need to refer to an article in open review, use the following format:
